Working with two floor-to-ceiling glass walls that look out onto a rooftop garden, the new ensuite prioritises functional living and is a serene space to be in. "I love the pervading sense of calm and the feeling that you are bathing in the garden while cut off from the hustle and bustle of the inner-city location.
